DISCOVERY LOCATION

FIRSTLY I would like to say this pan compared to the other pans was done through the sweep pan function of the Sony A99 and that is why its size is so much smaller compared to the others and this is the first Panorama I took at Isandlwana back in 2012 as compared to the others which were taken 4 years later with a tripod and joining over 100 separate photos all together.

As you compare the locations from the other Panoramas you can tell the change of such areas as the wooded area near the Donga this one shows the trees fully grown and the others in the section DISCOVERY OF THE ZULU ARMY shows that the trees have been cut down. On my next visit I will upgrade this Panorama to my standard system.

What is important is that the English pickets which all three locations covered the entire length of the iNyoni ridge only had limited view of the discovery location but what confirms this location to be the location of the discovery is Trooper Barkers find of a large Zulu army only a short distance from Itusi "

The Zulus then remained on the hills and about 200 advanced to 300 meters of us { so from 300 meters to the left of Itusi is where these 200 Zulus advancing they retired { to the left away from trooper Barker } and on a further hill 600 yards we saw a large Zulu army. As you can see what trooper Barker discovered is in fact the same zulu's Lieutenant Raw and Roberts would bump into less than one hour after trooper Barker's discovery.

Mkwene the only reference feature you can spot from Mkwene is 90% of the wooded area on the far left the Donga in front of the wooded area can not be seen. Which confirms all the Zulus were placed on the other side of the donga
